# What is VTAC?

- The Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre administers the application processes for places in tertiary courses, scholarships and the Special Entry Access Scheme at universities, TAFEs and independent tertiary colleges in Victoria.
- All Year 12 students apply through VTAC for tertiary courses in Victoria.
- VTAC also calculates the Victorian ATAR and provides enquiry services for applicants and schools.
- Students wanting to apply interstate need to do so through the TAC that services that state.




## **Course Fee Types**

#### Course codes ending in:

- 1: Are Commonwealth supported places (subsidised).
- 2: Are domestic fee places.
- **3**: Are international fee places.
- **4**: Have the fee-type determined by provider at enrolment (usually subsidised for Year 12 students under 20 years of age).

Study loans are **not** administered by VTAC.






# **Applying For Courses**



# **Unique Student Identifier (USI)**

- Unique student number issued by Australian Government.
- Required to create a VTAC account, as all students commencing tertiary courses must now have a USI.
- Can be created (or retrieved if forgotten) at usi.gov.au.






# **Creating a VTAC Account**

Only create a VTAC account once in year 12.


The following personal details are required:

- Full name
- Gender
- Date of birth
- Citizenship details (including passport details and visa information for international students)
- VCE/IB student number
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Email address
- USI (now mandatory)





# All VTAC services are accessed via the same VTAC account





### **Applying for courses**


List up to eight courses/institutions

**Preference order** – always list courses in the order you want to get into them

To add course preferences: Select institution and/or course or type in the course code.

**To move a course** on the preference list use the up/down buttons.


To delete a course use the x button.





### Don't use school email addresses


- An alert message appears if an applicant enters an "edu.au" address.
- This warning is to prevent applicants being unable to access offers if the school email account has been closed by January.
- The message is a warning only: the applicant can still choose to proceed with using the schoolbased email address.



### **Preferences**

- Important -
  - List preferences in the order you actually want the courses.
  - You will receive a maximum of one offer per round, from the <u>highest</u> preference willing to make an offer.
  - You won't find out about any <u>lower</u> preference courses.
- Early-closing courses can't be re-added to the preferences list after their closing date
- Use the qualification level filter or check the description to ensure students are applying for the correct course level.

# **Supplementary Offers**

#### What is it?

- Opt-in system for domestic applicants who do not receive preference-based offers.
- Applicants who opt-in and haven't received an offer by February Round 1 may be contacted by other courses with vacancies.
- All applicants should opt-in when applying (permission can be changed later in the VTAC account on the course offers tab).

#### INFORMATION RELEASE

1. VTAC is currently negotiating with the media to publish offer names on their media platforms (print, digital) for first and second offer intakes in 2017.

2. Supplementary offers is a service that allows courses with vacancies to make offers to applicants who have received no offers up until and including Round two for 2017. In the event that you don't receive any offers for the first and second intakes in January and February 2017 we need your consent before we forward your details onto courses with vacancies. You can opt out of this process at any time



# **Course Application Payment**

- 2023 timely application fee for current year 12 students: \$55
- Late fee \$140 / very late \$180
- Pay using a credit or debit card via PayPal. (A PayPal account is <u>not</u> required).
- Best to make payment at the time of submitting an application so you don't forget!





# **Applying For SEAS and Scholarships**



# Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS)

One application form covering special consideration for 27 institutions



Increases the selection rank of eligible applicants to compensate for disadvantage



SEAS is not a separate quota or pool of places. Selection is still competitive.



Consideration is applied in accordance with each institution's policy, so may be different between courses.



SEAS does not exempt applicants from essential requirements and admission criteria, e.g. prerequisites



Application completed online, available in the VTAC account after submitting course preferences.



The outcome of a SEAS application is confidential and not disclosed to the applicant.


# Change of Preference – beware many dates!

- Victorian students can change preferences until 13 December for consideration for the December round.
- International student timeline is the same as domestic for December round, then dates differ.
- Students can change preferences after December round in time for January between 21 December @2pm- 22 December @4pm.


### **Release of Offers**

### Your Options When You Receive An Offer




Check enrolment information carefully as this is different for each course.

If you get an offer in your VTAC account but no enrolment information from the institution, contact the institution directly to follow this up.



### **Preference System**



**Higher** preference courses. Automatically considered in future rounds

Offered course – can't be removed but can be moved

Lower preferences.

Not considered unless
moved above offered course.


