






I am aware of the subjects I may need to study for a pathway I could pursue when I leave school.




On a scale of 1-10, I have already been having conversations with my parents about possible subjects for Y12 in 2026:

The **Five**VCE Unit 3 & 4 studies
in Year 12



For successful completion of the VCE students must successfully complete an 'English block' Unit 3 & 4 study sequence



In addition, Year 12 students undertake **four** other Unit 3 & 4 study sequence



Further, all students undertake Religious Education as part of their VCE



All students will have study periods and Oratory as part of their VCE





(2026) Application to transfer to the VCE VM Trogram (Year 12)

The VCE Vocational Major (VM) is a vocational and applied learning program within the VCE designed to be completed over a minimum of two years. The VCE VM will give students greater thoice and flexibility to pursue their strengths and interests and develop the skills and capabilities needed to succeed in further education, work and life.

The VCE VM prepares students to move into apprenticeships, frainceships, further education and training, university (via non-ATAR pathways) or directly into the workforce.

The purpose of the VCE VM is to provide students with the best apportunity to achieve their personal goals and aspirations in a rapidly changing world by:

- equipping them with the skills, knowledge, values and capabilities to be active and informed citizens, lifelong learners and confident and creative individuals; and
- empowering them to make informed decisions about the next stages of their lives through real life workplace expenences.

Students in the VCE VM (Year 12, 2026) will complete the following compulsory subjects including:

- Senior VCE VM Literacy
- Senior VCE VM Numeracy
- Senior VCE VM Personal Development Skills
- Senior VCE VM Work Related Skills
- Senior VCE VM Business Studies (Cert II in Business).
- a VET subject of their choice.
- Year 12 Religious Education

Students transferring from VCE to the VCE Vocational Major (VM) can receive their full certificate IF they meet all the requirements of the VCE VM for 2026 including completion of two VET Dertificate II studies

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- St Joseph's College cannot guarantee selection or enrolment in any VET studies for 2026. Students should complete an Application to undertake a VET Study form in addition to this form.
- Students will be required to attend any compulsory orientation/enrolment sessions for the VCE VM (Year 12, 2026). Details will be provided to students in advance of the session.
- · An interview may be required to finalise your application

Instructions

This form is so be completed by students who wish to undertake the VCE VM (Year 12) in 2026, Soudents who are applying to transfer into the VCE VM program are still required to submit subjects that form a VCE Program we the Online Subject Selection Portal.


The link will take Students directly to the Subject Selection Portal Homepage.




Click + Add New Preferences to begin.



Students select their preferred program for 2026 VCE or VCE Vocational Major (VM)








Students begin to select their preferences:

Click Proceed to continue.




Students confirm their preferences and sign (electronically) to acknowledge that they are correct.
