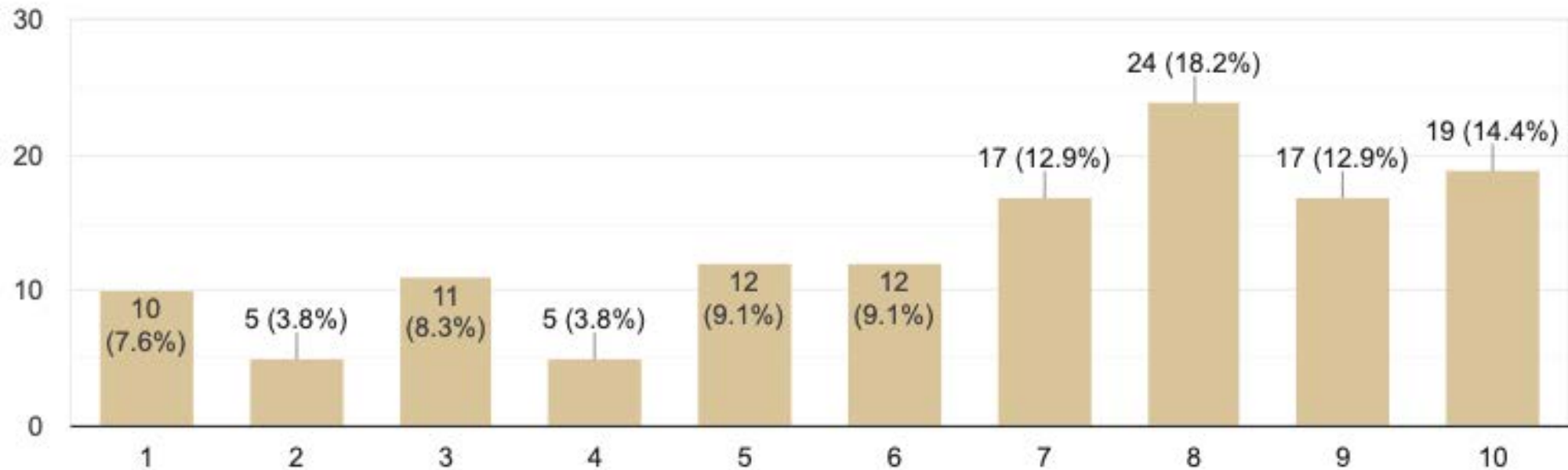


Subject Selection Survey Data

On a scale of 1-10, I have already been thinking about my possible subjects for Y12 in 2024:



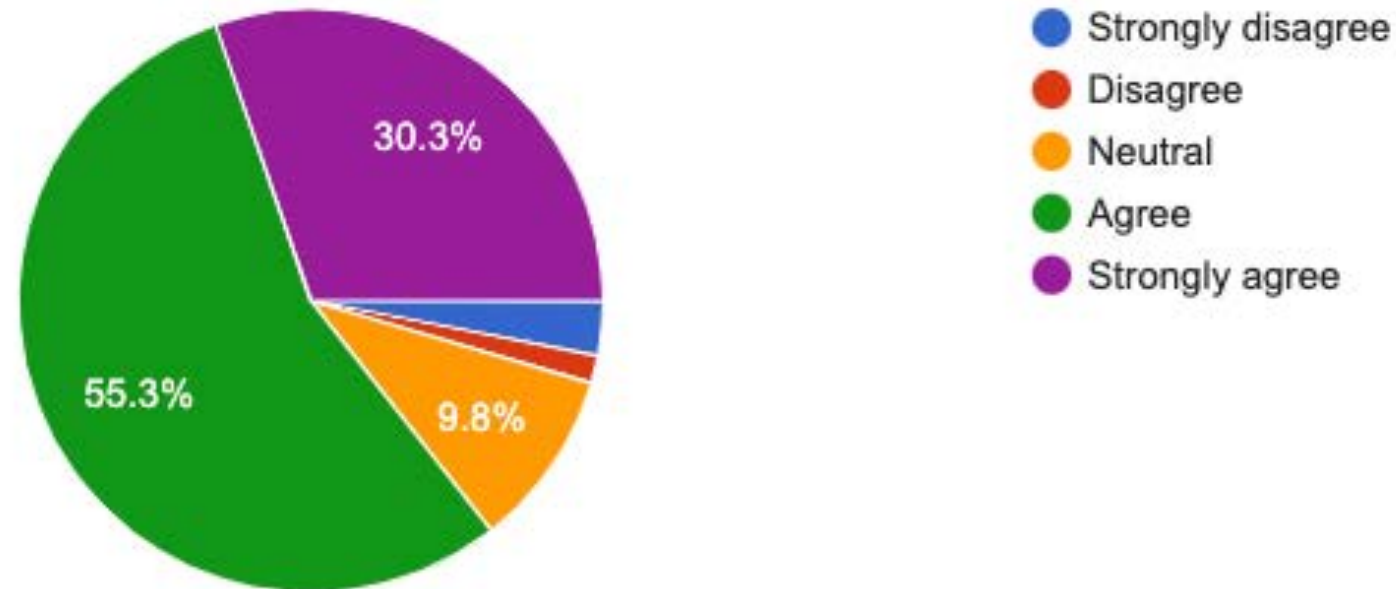

I am aware of the subjects I currently *enjoy* studying.

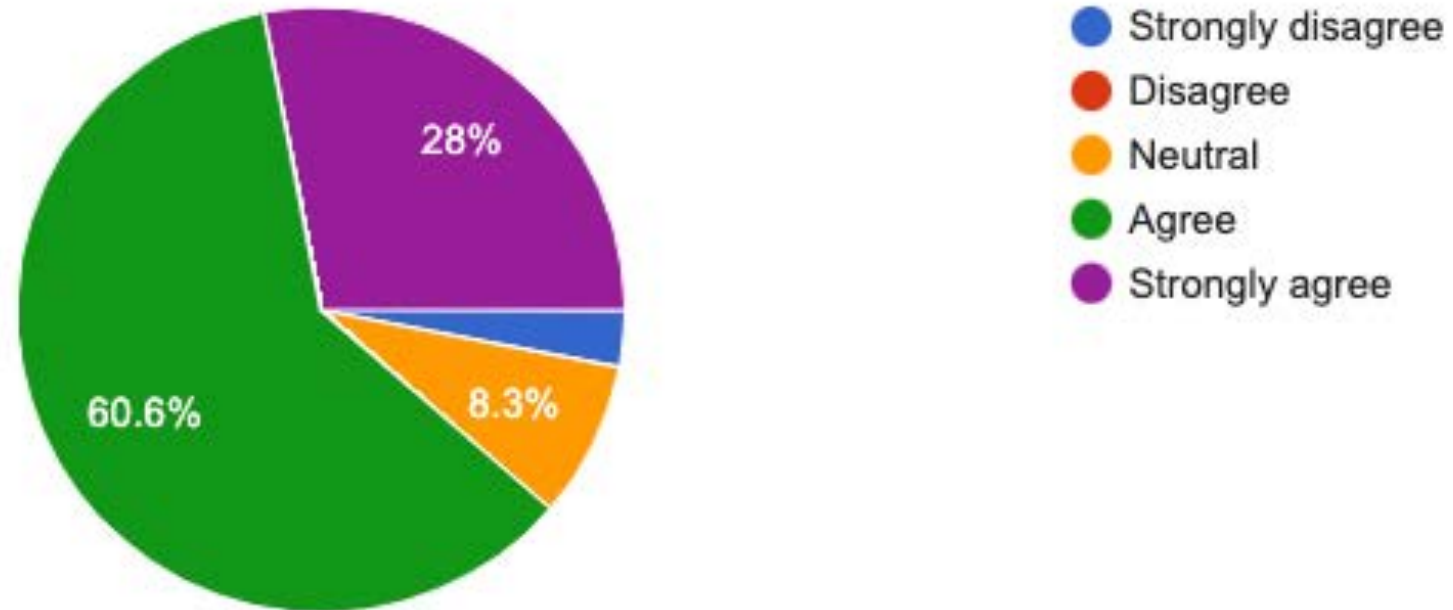

I am aware of the subjects that I believe I am *good* at.

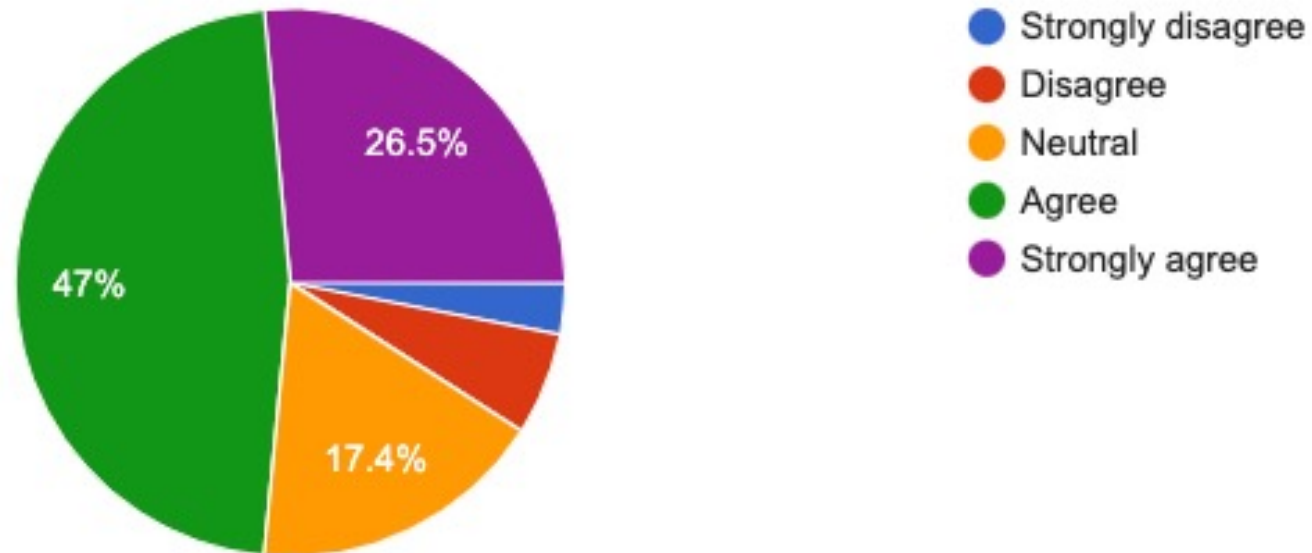

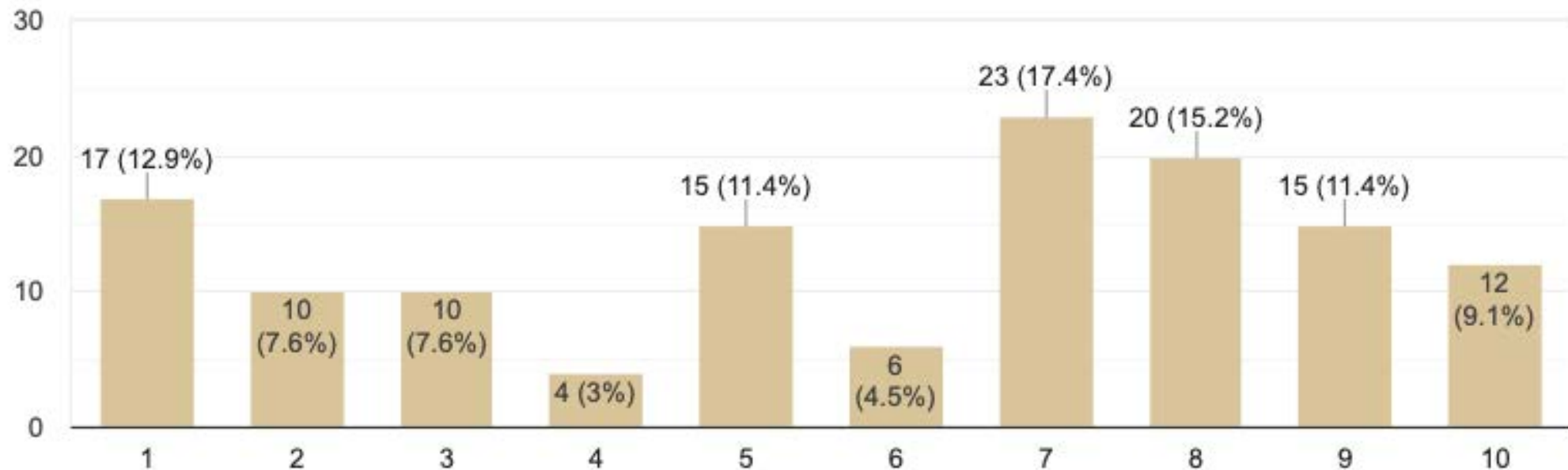


Subject Selection Survey Data

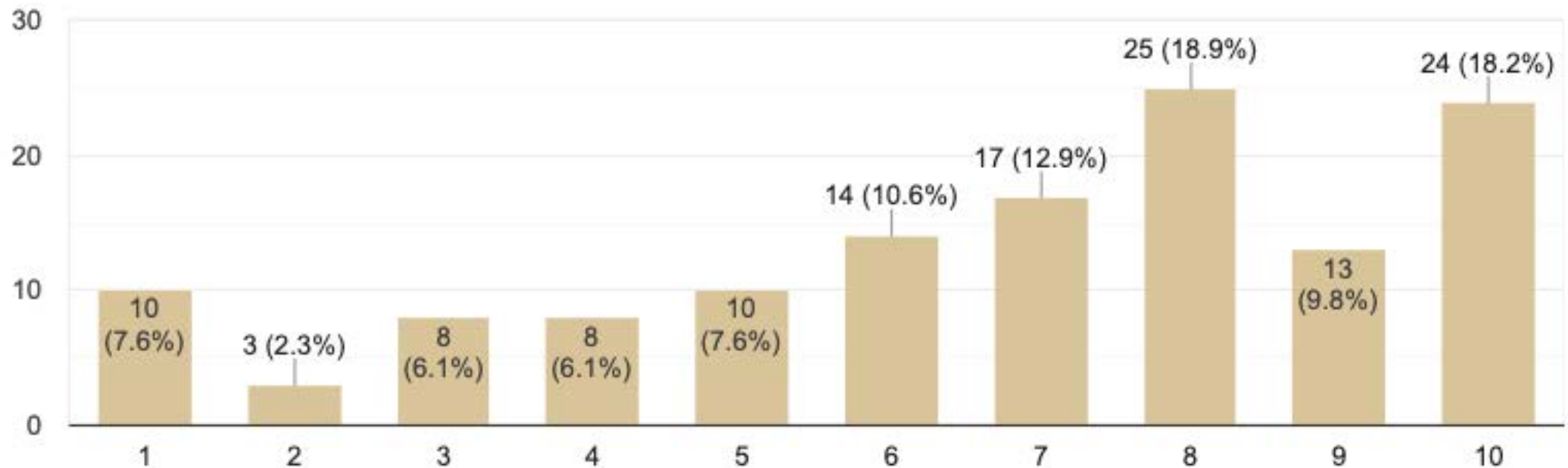

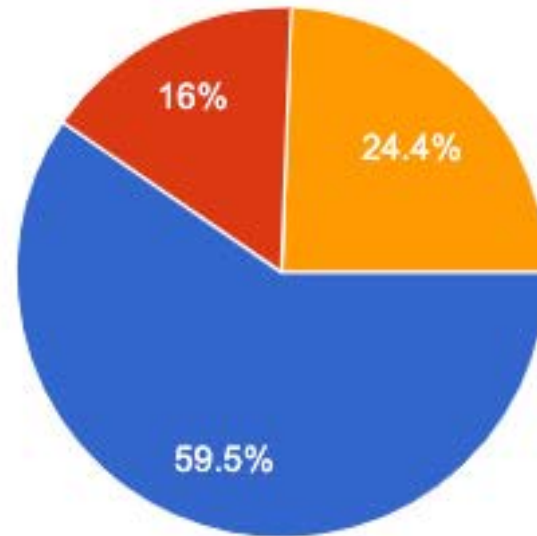

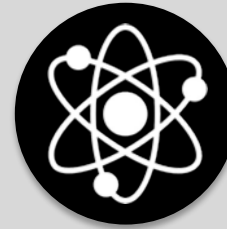
