

Lord, you call us by name and you call us to holiness, as you did St Joseph and St John Bosco.





On a scale of 1-10, I have already been thinking about my possible subjects for Y10 in 2024:









Subject Selection Survey Data



I am aware of the subjects I may need to study for a pathway I could purse when I leave school.



Offered mainly by TAFE providers



Mainly hands on

In the Pathways stage students both receive a broad education and begin to plan their senior secondary program of study

THE VICTORIAN CURRICULUM

How is it structured?



Organised across two semesters



Religious Education, English, Mathematics and Health & PE run the whole year



All other Core studies run for ONE semester only (i.e. History)



Electives run for one semester only (exceptions apply)

Language and Music electives run the whole year



Accelerated VCE studies run the whole year



Students will receive an email containing their personalised link to the Online Subject Selection Portal.

The following steps outline how to enter your subject preferences online.

1 Internet Access You will need a computer with an internet connection and a printer.





Continue to select subjects in order of preference:


Use the 'Drop-Down' Menu





Continue with selecting preferences:

Keep in mind – Acceleration Subjects take up two preferences; Languages take up two preferences (We will 'tidy-up' any anomalies to fit four units into three spaces!)





Students confirm their preferences and sign (electronically)


Include Parent/Guardian email to ensure receipt is sent



Then Click + Submit Valid Preferences to continue.



The following confirmation appears when the process is complete.



Students may repeat the entire process to change their preferences until the cut off date.



C+ standard in Year 9 required for direct admission to Year 10 studies (exceptions apply)



Year 10 has SEVEN compulsory Core Studies



Core Religious Education, English and Mathematics run across
BOTH semesters



Core Science, Health and PE, History and Commerce are ONE semester in length



Additionally - THREE Elective spaces, each ONE semester in length

Accelerated studies are available to students meeting the criteria



Criteria: high level of achievement, attendance, organisation, maturity



Accelerated Studies require an application form



Students undertaking a VET study may not undertake second Accelerated Study
